Rector's Instruction 1/2020. (III.11.) regarding the Extraordinary Spring Break and Changes to the General Educational Regulations

Referring to the Government Decree 40/2020 (III.11.) on the State of Emergency, the General Regulations of EKU have been modified as follows:

- 1. A special teaching break will take place between 12th -14th March, 2020: all classes and consultations are cancelled on these days.
- 2. The 2019/2020 academic calendar is modified as follows: the spring break will take place between $16^{th}-21^{st}$ March, 2020 while the originally planned spring break ($14^{th}-17^{th}$ April, 2020) will be a study period and all classes will be held.
- 3. From March 23rd, all classes will be held in a distance learning format until further notice.
- 4. During the special teaching break and spring break, all tutors and departments should establish the appropriate conditions for distance learning. In this context, a detailed action plan will be elaborated upon soon.
- 5. All forms of student administration and contact with the tutors shall only take place electronically.
- 6. From the spring semester of 2019/20 academic year, section 51 § (3), point a) of the Code of Studies and Exams is modified as follows: theses shall be uploaded to the appropriate platform; printed copies shall not be submitted. In this context, section 51 § (3), point b, and the second sentence of section 52 § (1) shall be ignored.
- 7. From March 23, 2020, professional practices (including teaching internships at practice schools, dual practice and non-teaching practices) shall be suspended until further notice.
- 8. Until further notice, students with a permanent Hungarian address shall move out from all university managed dormitories by March 15th, 2020 at the latest.
- 9. As for academic and non-academic staff, non-teaching tasks shall be continued as usual until further notice.
- 10. From March 12th, 2020, visitors shall not enter the Lyceum, the Magic Tower and the Tittel Pál Library.
- 11. All other related issues will be communicated in a separate action plan announcement issued by the Eszterházy Károly University Epidemic Strategy Committee.
